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<b>Serve</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Uses proper grip and has the correct stance</li> <li>○ Holds birdie correctly to release for contact</li> <li>○ Uses underhand swing</li> <li>○ Understands the rules for serving singles &amp; doubles</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Drops birdie prior to swing and contact</li> <li>○ Makes contact below the waist</li> <li>○ Uses wrist on swing</li> <li>○ Redirects birdie forward</li> <li>○ Somewhat successful at serve</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Makes contact using legal swing</li> <li>○ Somewhat successful at serve</li> <li>○ Can somewhat aim the serve strategically</li> <li>○ Has developed a more consistent short serve</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Can vary depth and height of serve</li> <li>○ Short serve is low and offensive</li> <li>○ Long serve is deep and high</li> <li>○ Consistently serves with accuracy and intent</li> <li>○ Disguises their serves</li> </ul>			
<b>Clear</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Uses the clear at the appropriate time</li> <li>○ Chooses to use overhand swing when birdie is high</li> <li>○ Chooses underhand swing when birdie is too short or low</li> <li>○ Getting under the ball with right foot forward when setting</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Can redirect birdie upward using overhand swing</li> <li>○ Can redirect a low birdie over the net</li> <li>○ Little whip action to clear past “happy zone”</li> <li>○ Attempts to play the birdie forehand/backhand</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Somewhat successful at directing birdie to either the L/R purposefully</li> <li>○ Somewhat successful at low/high shots using forehand and backhand</li> <li>○ Can clear past the “happy zone” of opponent’s court</li> <li>○ Can move four steps or more and can still clear</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ From deep in the court hits deep into opponent’s</li> <li>○ Clears off forehand and backhand swings</li> <li>○ Able to send bird to L/R sides of opponent’s court</li> <li>○ Can disguise the clear with other shots</li> <li>○ Can clear from anywhere on the court</li> </ul>			
<b>Movement &amp; Positioning</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Stands in their position</li> <li>○ Afraid to move to play the bird</li> <li>○ Does not adjust to location of the serve</li> <li>○ Can not physically cover some parts of the court</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Moves to shots but remains there</li> <li>○ Understands the service rotation in singles/dbls</li> <li>○ Still does a lot of reaching (low movement)</li> <li>○ Wt. is on heels, slowing ability of a returned shot</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Student covers court, but finds still out of position</li> <li>○ Rarely stays on the balls of the feet</li> <li>○ Does not anticipate shots and is chasing a lot</li> <li>○ Returns to “T” 50%</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Student moves around covering everywhere and always attempts to return to the “T”</li> <li>○ Wt. is on the balls of feet</li> <li>○ Is in position to play all shots</li> <li>○ Anticipates opponents shots</li> <li>○ Moves before the opponent hits the shot</li> </ul>			
<b>Game or Court Strategies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Hits shots directly back to opponent and are easily returnable</li> <li>○ Does not communicate with partner</li> <li>○ Rarely see teamwork</li> <li>○ Continually hits to the middle of the court</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Uses some strategy to defeat an opponent</li> <li>○ Hits shots to open places on the court</li> <li>○ Communication and working with partner 50% of the time</li> <li>○ Starting to make opponent move</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Demonstrates evidence of strategy to defeat opponent</li> <li>○ Hits shots short/long to open places on the court</li> <li>○ Communicates with partner 75% of the time</li> <li>○ Can anticipate shots, but can’t always get to them</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Demonstrates much evidence of strategy to defeat opponent</li> <li>○ Always hits shots to the open places on the court</li> <li>○ Anticipates shots, moving to play them</li> <li>○ Consistently works well with partner</li> <li>○ They both move before the shot is returned</li> </ul>			

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
