

Basketball Passing 9th Grade Rubric

This rubric will help to grade skill level of students in the basketball pass. To achieve a skill number, students must demonstrate all of the skills in that scoring level. Emphasis is on the process and mechanics of the sports skill and not the end product.

Skill Number	Mechanics and Cues of Skill
1	<p style="text-align: center;">Basic Skill Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student takes no step while passing• Student passes the ball with hands closer to their chest but not in the right spot• Students pass is in-accurate• Student doesn't follow through• Student only uses 2 kinds of passes during games
	<p style="text-align: center;">Elementary Skill Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student takes a small step before they pass• Students hands are at their chest• Student makes a some-what accurate pass to their partner• Student follows through with thumbs down• Student uses 3 kinds of passes during games
3	<p style="text-align: center;">Intermediate Skill Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student takes a powerful step before they pass• Students hands are at their chest• Student makes an accurate pass to their partner• Student follows through with thumbs down• Student uses 4 kinds of passes during games
	<p style="text-align: center;">Exemplar Skill Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student passes at full speed• Student uses all kinds of passes during game situations• Student uses passes to allow others to score• Student passes are accurate and to teammates in motion• Student uses behind the back or bounce passes between the legs of opponents• Student uses passing more than dribbling to advance the ball and score• Student always fakes a pass to make a pass in a game situation
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
