



Behavior/Sportsmanship 8th Grade Rubric

This rubric will help to grade students on their daily behavior and sportsmanship in class. To achieve a skill number, students must demonstrate all of the skills in that scoring level. Emphasis is on daily behavior in class and going above and beyond what is required each day.

Skill Number	Explanation of Skill Level
1	 Basic Skill Level Student receives <u>4 or more</u> warnings/behavior marks throughout the period Student is off task/shows bad sportsmanship on a daily basis and their behavior continues until it is corrected by students or the teacher Student refuses to participate even when prompted
2	 Elementary Skill Level Student receives 2-4 warnings/behavior marks throughout the period Student is off task/shows bad sportsmanship on a daily basis and their behavior continues until it is corrected by students or the teacher Student is not actively working on their skills
3	 Intermediate Skill Level Student receives <u>1 or less</u> warnings/behavior marks throughout the period Student is on task during class and demonstrates good sportsmanship but does not help others to stay on task Student is participating but not on skills
4	 Exemplar Skill Level Student receives <u>0</u> warnings/behavior marks throughout the period Student helps others to stay on task, shows good sportsmanship during all activities, and is a leader during class by setting a good example for behavior/sportsmanship Student is working on their skill development
