



# Behavior/Sportsmanship 9th Grade Rubric

This rubric will help to grade students on their daily behavior and sportsmanship in class. To achieve a skill number, students must demonstrate all of the skills in that scoring level. Emphasis is on daily behavior in class and going above and beyond what is required each day.

# Skill Number

## **Explanation of Skill Level**

1

#### Basic Skill Level

- Student receives <u>3 or more</u> warnings/behavior marks throughout the period
- Student is off task/shows bad sportsmanship and their behavior continues until it is corrected by students or the teacher
- Student refuses to participate even when prompted
- Student has cellphone out and ear-buds in

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### **Elementary Skill Level**

- Student receives 2-3 warnings/behavior marks throughout the period
- Student is off task/shows bad sportsmanship and their behavior continues until it is corrected by students or the teacher
- Student is not actively working on their skills
- Student has their cellphone out and ear-buds in

### Intermediate Skill Level

- Student receives **1** warning/behavior mark throughout the period
- Student is on task during class and demonstrates good sportsmanship but does not help others to stay on task
- Student is participating but not on skills
- Student never has their cellphone or ear-buds on their persons unless told they can

## Exemplar Skill Level

- Student receives **0** warnings/behavior marks throughout the period
- Student helps others to stay on task, shows good sportsmanship during all activities, and is a leader during class by setting a good example for behavior/sportsmanship
- Student is working on their skill development
- Student never has their cellphone or ear-buds on their persons unless told they can
