## Behavior/Sportsmanship Team Sports Rubric

This rubric will help to grade students on their daily behavior and sportsmanship in class. To achieve a skill number, students must demonstrate all of the skills in that scoring level. Emphasis is on daily behavior in class and going above and beyond what is required each day.

# Skill Number

## **Explanation of Skill Level**

1

#### **Basic Skill Level**

- Student receives 2-3 warnings/behavior marks throughout the period
- Student is off task/shows bad sportsmanship on a daily basis and their behavior continues until it is corrected by students or the teacher

2

### **Elementary Skill Level**

- Student receives 1 or less warnings/behavior marks throughout the unit
- Student is on task during class and demonstrates good sportsmanship but does not help others to stay on task

3

### Intermediate Skill Level

- Student receives **1** warnings/behavior marks throughout the unit
- Student is on task during class and demonstrates good sportsmanship but does not help others to stay on task
- Student doesn't use foul language or taunt anyone

4

### Exemplar Skill Level

- Student receives 0 warnings/behavior marks throughout the unit
- Student helps others to stay on task, shows good sportsmanship during all activities, and is a leader during class by setting a good example for behavior/sportsmanship
- Student doesn't use foul language or taunt anyone
- Student always helps others up when they fall
- Student is looking for ways to prevent bullying in the class
