### Mechanics and Cues of Skill

# 1

#### **Basic Skill Level**

- Student does not have proper grip on the laces of the football
- Student does not take a step or steps with wrong leg
- Student does not use proper arm mechanics and does not throw a spiral
- Student can throw accurately to their target

# 2

#### **Elementary Skill Level**

- Student does not have proper grip on the laces of the football
- Student takes a small step with their opposite leg or steps with wrong leg
- Student does not use proper arm mechanics
- Student throws a spiral
- Student can throw accurately to their target

# 3

#### Intermediate Skill Level

- Student has proper grip on the laces of the football
- Student takes a step with their opposite leg
- Student uses proper arm mechanics and throws a spiral
- Student can throw accurately to their target
- Student can hit a moving target

### Exemplar Skill Level

- Student has proper grip on the laces of the football
- Student takes a step with their opposite leg
- Student uses proper arm mechanics and throws a spiral
- Student can throw accurately to their target
- Studnet can hit a moving target
- Student can hit a moving target while they are moving
