## Volleyball Serving Overhand 8th Grade Rubric

This rubric will help to grade skill level of students in volleyball serving mechanics. To achieve a skill number, students must demonstrate all of the skills in that scoring level. Emphasis is on the process and mechanics of the sports skill and not the end product.

## Skill Mechanics and Cues of Skill Number Basic Skill Level Serving hand is not ready and at shoulder/head level Student does not have a good throw over the serving hand Students swings serving hand and makes poor contact with their palm Student does not take a step forward with their non-serving leg Elementary Skill Level Serving hand is not ready and at shoulder/head level Student does not consistently have a good throw over the serving hand Students swings serving hand and makes poor contact with Student takes a small step or no step forward with their nonserving leg Intermediate Skill Level Serving hand is ready and at shoulder/head level Student does not consistently have a good throw over the serving hand Students swings serving hand and makes average contact with their palm Student takes a step forward with their non-serving leg Advanced Skill Level Serving hand is ready and at shoulder/head level Student has a good throw over the serving hand Students swings serving hand and makes contact with their Student takes a step forward with their non-serving leg

Student follows through with their serving hand producing an accurate serve over the net more times then they don't
